2020 Refresher

The Backstory:

- The Board elected to take the existing control framework (drafted previously) and narrow them down to a "top 50" while mapping to published controls across CSA, OWASP, ISO etc.
 - Understanding this will be a baseline framework and will grow organically over time.
- In April, Technology Committee Tri-Chair (Micah, Todd, Mischa) elected and assigned as priority.
 - Covid Pandemic did not help this exercise but managed to organize after some delay.
- In July, in an effort to manage the task and utilize our industry partners, workstreams were formed.
- Through August and September, workstream teams were solidified and initial workshops conducted.

Key Points:

- Writing and maintaining custom controls requires a huge (volunteer) effort
 - Start with leveraging what is "established" and grow organically over time
- Cloud platforms are innovating new products at pace, tough to keep controls aligned
 - Leverage each cloud platforms specific best practice and design patterns
- Cybersecurity needs to be seen as a business risk, not a technical discipline
 - Deliver documentation in a usable format that is easily applied to any size of business
- Consensus across security community in M&E, ratification by Studio security leads
 - Baseline candidate for framework will require ongoing development

Phases

- PHASE 1 (active): Controls mapped to industry frameworks
 - CSA, CIS, OWASP, ISO, MPA
- PHASE 2 (partially active): Best practice documentation
 - Major cloud platforms
- PHASE 3 (TBD): Process workflow
 - Configure existing documentation systems in common use
 - Minimise custom development to reduce cost, minimise risk and deliver fast
 - Propose and review with board
- FUTURE (needs planning)
 - Dynamic updates from other industry control frameworks and ME-ISAC
 - People (cloud certification, media skills)
 - Audit Process, Controlled Access, Shared Resources
 - General Business Model organization

.....Since Our Last September Meeting


- Refreshed Workstream Leaders and Co-Leads

- To maintain focus, we organized regular cadence of "sync" meetings
- Held instructional workshops to address any misalignment, clarify mappings and addressed general Q&A
- "Lessons Learned" was shared to other workstreams to answer questions they may not have had
- Overall, workstreams have risen to the challenge of balancing "day job's & pandemic"
 - Enthusiasm is high to take our industry forward on Cloud and Application Best Practices


- Top 50 Categories ready

- Overview structure for target 500 controls




Latest Statistics on Mapping Progress
